



**Women's Club of Greater Lakeway
Articles of Incorporation**

Article I - Entity Name and Type

The filing entity being formed is a nonprofit corporation. The corporation is organized pursuant to the Texas Business Organizations Code (BOC). The period of duration is perpetual, unless dissolved according to the laws of the State of Texas.

The name of the entity is: The Women's Club of Greater Lakeway.

Article II - Registered Agent and Registered Office

Article IV - Membership

The nonprofit corporation shall have members. Membership is available to women who live or work within the City of Lakeway, the Lakeway ETJ, the Village of the Hills, and the southeastern geographic areas located west of 620 and north of 71 to the current Lakeway and Lakeway ETJ borders, including the Bella Colina community. Members who later relocate outside these areas may continue their membership. Non-resident property owners, regardless of prior membership, may continue to be or become WCGL members of the greater Lakeway area.

Article V - Purpose

This corporation is organized exclusively as a social and recreational club under Section 501(c)(7) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

The purpose of the Women's Club of Greater Lakeway shall be to promote the social, cultural, and intellectual growth of its members.

Article VI – Dissolution

Upon the dissolution or winding up of the affairs of this club, the Board of Directors, after providing for the payment of all obligations, shall equally distribute any remaining assets to the current members living for whom current mailing addresses are known.
